KANAAN READY TO CELEBRATE AGAIN:

Texas Motor Speedway holds fond memories for reigning Indy 500 champion Tony Kanaan. Victory in the June 2004 race helped secure his lone series title, which he celebrated following the October race at the speedway in which he finished second. This will mark Kanaan's 204th consecutive Indy car start, which is seven off the record by team co-owner, Jimmy Vasser.
