

## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

CAN HELIO WIN A FOURTH INDY 500?: Threetime Indianapolis 500 winner Helio Castroneves can join elite company should he win the 2014 Indianapolis 500 Mile Race. Castroneves, who won in 2001, 2002 and 2009, would join A.J. Foyt, Al Unser and Rick Mears as the race's only four-time winners — and he would accomplish the feat faster than any of those racing legends.



RHR LOOKS TO ADD TO RÉSUMÉ AT INDY: 2012 saw the emergence of Ryan Hunter-Reay as a champion race car driver. Now his next challenge is to place his likeness on the Borg-Warner Trophy. Can Hunter-Reay become the first American to win the Indy 500 since 2006?

SECOND-GENERATION STARS: The latest generation from two of open-wheel racing's most familiar families comes to Indianapolis in hopes of adding to the family legacy. Marco Andretti – the grandson of 1969 winner Mario Andretti and son of Michael Andretti – has finished in the top three at Indy three times in his eight previous starts. He hopes to give his father's team its third Indianapolis 500 win. Another son hoping to return his father's team to Victory Circle is Graham Rahal. The son of 1986 winner Bobby Rahal races for his family's team, hoping to improve on his best finish of third in 2011.

**GENERATION NEXT:** James Hinchcliffe, Simon Pagenaud and Charlie Kimball all scored their first win in 2013, finished top 10 in the championship standings and established themselves as the next stars of the sport. Will 2014 be the year a new, young star becomes a "500" winner?



STOCK CAR STAR TO PULL DOUBLE DUTY: Kurt Busch will attempt to become the fourth driver to complete the Memorial Day Double by racing in the Indianapolis 500 and Coca-Cola 600 NASCAR race. John Andretti, Tony Stewart and Robby Gordon are the only drivers to compete in both races on the same day. Can Busch match the feat of his NASCAR team owner Stewart by finishing all 1,100 miles of racing on May 25?

PENSKE SEEKS HISTORY: Team owner Roger Penske has won the Indianapolis 500 a record 15 times and brings three strong entries in 2014 with three-time Indianapolis 500 winner Helio Castroneves, series points leader Will Power and 2000 Indianapolis 500 winner Juan Pablo Montoya. Can the three drivers become the first team to finish 1-2-3 at Indy and complete the Captain's sweep?
