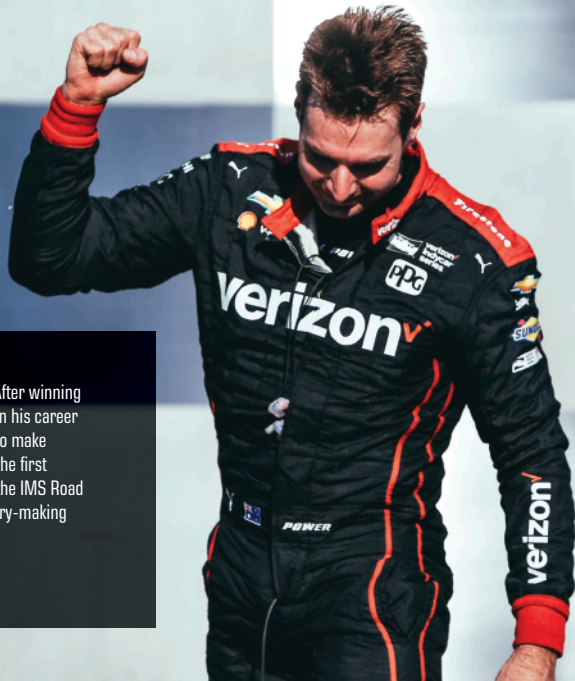

## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:


**WILL HELIO WIN FOURTH INDY 500?:** Three-time Indianapolis 500 winner Helio Castroneves can join elite company should he win the Indianapolis 500-Mile Race. Castroneves, who won in 2001, 2002 and 2009, would join A.J. Foyt, Al Unser and Rick Mears as the race's only four-time winners.

**FORMER CHAMPIONS RETURN IN SEARCH OF SECOND WIN:** Five former Indianapolis 500 winners return with eyes on adding a second Baby Borg to their collection. 2008 winner Scott Dixon and 2013 winner Tony Kanaan return with the formidable Chip Ganassi Racing team. Ryan Hunter-Reay and reigning champion Alexander Rossi will aim to bring Andretti Autosport another win in the Indy 500 and Buddy Lazier returns with Lazier-Burns Racing 20 years after claiming his Indy 500 win. Can a former winner score a second Indianapolis win?


**FROM THE POLE TO VICTORY LANE:** The winner of the pole position for the Indianapolis 500 has also won the race 20 times. Forty-three times, the winner has come from the front row, the last time in 2010 with Dario Franchitti. Who can establish themselves as a race contender by winning the pole position or qualifying on the front row this year?

**PENSKE SEEKS HISTORY:** Team owner Roger Penske has won the Indianapolis 500 a record 16 times and brings five strong entries in 2017 with three-time Indianapolis 500 winner Helio Castroneves, two-time Indianapolis 500 winner Juan Pablo Montoya, series points leader Simon Pagenaud, former Verizon IndyCar Series champion Will Power and rising star Josef Newgarden. Can the fearsome fivesome become the first team to lock out the podium and complete the Captain's sweep?

**DIVERSE ROOKIE CLASS HOPES TO MAKE STRONG IMPRESSION:** The rookie class features a two-time Formula One champion, the reigning Indy Lights champion, one of two drivers to win races on the Indianapolis Motor Speedway's road course and oval and a driver who has competed in all three levels of the Mazda Road to Indy. The 2017 rookies are: Fernando Alonso, Jack Harvey, Ed Jones and Zach Veach.

## QUALIFYING 101

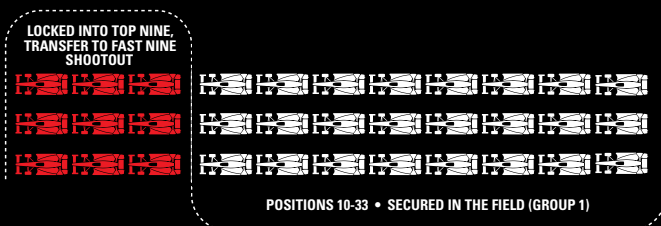
### SATURDAY, MAY 20: QUALIFICATIONS

**SETTING THE FIELD:** At the conclusion of Saturday qualifications, the starting field for the 101st Running of the Indianapolis 500 is set. All entries are guaranteed one qualification attempt.\*

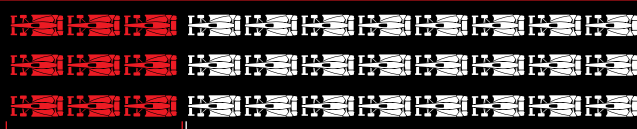
**MULTIPLE ATTEMPTS:** Multiple attempts are permitted with or without withdrawing a previous time.

**POSITIONS 1-9:** The fastest nine entries are locked into the field and advance to May 21's Fast Nine Shootout.

**POSITIONS 10-33:** Locked into field and advance to Group 1 qualifying on May 21 to determine starting order.



### SUNDAY, MAY 21: ARMED FORCES POLE DAY



**STARTING ORDER:** May 20 qualifying times are erased. All entries must make another four-lap qualifying attempt to determine their position, in the following groups:

**GROUP 1 (2:45-4:45 PM):** Determines starting positions 10-33. Each entry makes one attempt in order based on slowest to fastest from May 20 qualifying times.

**FAST NINE SHOOTOUT (5-5:45 PM):** Fastest nine qualifiers must make one four-lap attempt, in order based on slowest to fastest from May 20 qualifying times, to determine their starting position in the first three rows, including pole position and the Verizon P1 Award.

\* Per the 2017 Verizon IndyCar Series Rule Book, if a car is unable to complete its one guaranteed attempt on Saturday, May 20 because of a mechanical condition or incident, it may be designated by INDYCAR as an "Unqualified Car" and eligible to participate in "Last Chance Qualifying" on Sunday, May 21 from 1:45 - 2:00 p.m. ET.
