



WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

ANDRETTI AUTOSPORT GOES FOR SEVENTH STRAIGHT IOWA WIN: No team has been more successful at lowa Speedway than Andretti Autosport, which has won seven of the nine races at INDYCAR's shortest track. Ryan Hunter-Reay has won three times in four years for the team, which has six consecutive wins with four drivers. Can Andretti Autosport maintain its mastery of lowa Speedway?



KANAAN, DIXON TRY TO RECAPTURE SUCCESS: Chip Ganassi Racing's Scott Dixon and Tony Kanaan return to lowa Speedway hoping to return to their winning ways. Kanaan won at lowa in 2010 when he drove for Andretti Green Racing. Now he drives Chip Ganassi Racing's No. 10 car, which won the race in 2008 with the late Dan Wheldon and in 2009 with Dario Franchitti. Dixon has six top-10 finishes at lowa, but has never finished better than third. Can either win the track's iconic gas pump trophy and give the team a third lowa win?

PAGENAUD LOOKS TO KEEP POINTS LEAD: With seven races to go, Simon Pagenaud remains the man to beat for the 2016 Verizon IndyCar Series championship. A three-time race winner this season, Pagenaud leads Team Penske teammate Helio Castroneves by 74 points with a tight race of other title hopefuls just behind, including Will Power, who has won the last two races and is 81 points back. Scott Dixon (90 points back), Josef Newgarden (92 back) and Tony Kanaan (95 back) all have hopes of finishing strong and taking the title from Pagenaud.

PIT STOP TIMER: GREEN

Display shows a running clock during a pit stop in seconds.

Example: 7.9-second pit stop.
