WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

GANASSI EYES ANOTHER MID-OHIO WIN: After sweeping the podium at Pocono *(right)* and winning both races at Toronto, Chip Ganassi Racing hopes to keep its successful run going at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course, where it has won the last four races. Scott Dixon – who has won the last three IZOD IndyCar Series races – has won three of the last four races at Mid-Ohio, including back-to-back wins in 2011-12. Can Ganassi keep the Mid-Ohio streak alive?



HELIO LOOKS TO HOLD CHAMPIONSHIP LEAD: Helio Castroneves took control of the IZOD IndyCar Series standings with his victory at Texas Motor Speedway in early June and carries a 39-point advantage into the Honda Indy 200 at Mid-Ohio. Castroneves, who has recorded nine consecutive top-10 finishes, seeks his first victory at Mid-Ohio since 2001.

RAHAL RETURNS HOME: Graham Rahal is in his first season driving for Rahal Letterman Lanigan Racing – the team co-owned by his father. The Rahal name is synonymous with Victory Circle at Mid-Ohio and the 24-year-old driver of the No. 15 Midas/Big O Tires car would like nothing more than to win at his "home track." Can Rahal earn his first victory of the season at Mid-Ohio?
